Keep Those Eyes Peeled

As I write this, the sun is shining, and the hour change has heralded the arrival of the new season. Yes, it's spring again, and time to prepare yourselves to make inroads into all those new aircraft that have been delivered in the dark days of winter, and those currently on the assembly lines in Seattle, Toulouse, Sao Joao dos Campos and Toronto. Looking a little further ahead, I was amazed to read today that new 'Twotters' will be rolling off the lines again in 2008, for the first time in 20 years. Apparently the replacement for a DHC-6 is another DHC-6. Does that remind you of any other type at all?

Anyway, thanks to the wonders of modern technology, I thought it would be informative to give the airliner enthusiasts amongst the ranks a 'heads up' on forthcoming deliveries that you may see on your travels around the country in the next few months. Starting close to home, **easyJet** will be taking A319s G-EZBL to G-EZBY over the next couple of months, whilst **Ryanair** will have up to EI-DPZ, followed by EI-DWA-DWD in July. **XL Airways** will have G-XLAO (32690) very shortly, and over at Birmingham **FlyBe** are receiving EMB-195s G-FBED/E/F by June. If you're heading to Heathrow you can look out for **BA** A321 G-EUXJ (3081) in May, and **Virgin** A340 G-VJAM in July.

You've probably read about the new EU/US Open Skies agreement, which some think will lead to many new Transatlantic services opening. This doesn't take effect until 2008, and most US carriers have few new aircraft on order to take rapid advantage of these new services. Several carriers are transferring 757s from US Domestic to Transatlantic services however. Unfortunately not to be seen in the UK this summer (but can be seen at Brussels, Amsterdam, Düsseldorf & Frankfurt) will be **Northwest's** wingletted 757s N535US-540US & N544US-549US. They will also have new A330s N816NW (827) and N817NW (843) by June. **Continental** should have new 777s N77019 & N69020 by the end of April.

There are really too many new 'frames due to list them all, but here are a few of the other more interesting ones that will hopefully visit these shores or the nearer continental hubs over the coming months.

Other EMA news . . .

The new "pier" is progressing well and will be operational by May 1st 2007 in readiness for the busy summer season – it will permit six additional stands to be "walked" to by passengers. The terminal building is changing dramatically inside with security now moved down to where Ilkeston Co-Op used to be, the new "bus interchange" already open and new shops being fitted out in the departure lounge.

A new Travel Inn hotel, located next to the current Holiday Inn Express hotel, is due to open in June.

Over at the Aeropark, a new "entrance" building is under construction providing a much better environment for the AVA members who man this facility. Also planning permission is being sought for a new 4 metre high viewing mound at the eastern end of the park that will create much better viewing opportunities than those at the end of the Nags Head Lane. News of a fascinating lecture on the evening of the 16th April . . .

The Lecture is by Captain Eric Winkle Brown

Location: Rolls-Royce Hucknall Welfare Pavilion, Watnall Road.

Captain Eric “Winkle” Brown, CBE, DSC,AFC, FRAeS, RN

No test pilot in history has amassed a track record to compare with that of Captain Eric Brown, whose 31-year career with Britain's Royal Navy included a stint during World War II as the chief test pilot at the Royal Aircraft Establishment in Farnborough. Born in January 1919, his first experience of flying was at the age of eight, at the controls was his father, who had been in the Royal Flying Corps during WWI.

Eric, first flew at the age of 18, learning to fly on his own whilst a student at Edinburgh University, in 1939 his flying career nearly came to an abrupt end, whilst on a University exchange course in Germany where he was arrested by the Gestapo, it was only at this point Eric found out Britain was at war, luckily not realising he was a pilot in the RAF volunteer reserve he was released, the rest is now history.

He joined the Fleet Air Arm and after World War II commanded Enemy Aircraft Flight, an elite group of pilots who test-flew captured German aircraft. He went on to be the greatest test pilot in history, flying more different aircraft types than anyone else today. He is the only man alive who has flown every major (and most minor) combat aircraft of the Second World War as well as all the early jets. Speaking perfect German, he went to Germany in 1945 to test the Nazi jets, interviewing (among others) Hermann Goering, Hanna Reitsch and Werner Von Braun. He flight-tested 53 German aircraft, including the Me 163 rocket plane and the Messerschmitt Me 262 jet plane



Here are just a few of his achievements -

- Holds the GUINNESS BOOK OF WORLD RECORDS for most aircraft types flown. As a Royal Navy officer and test pilot who has flown more types of aircraft than anyone else in history 487 in total this does not include the different variants
- He is the Fleet Air Arm's most decorated pilot
- On December 3, 1945, Brown made the world's first landing of a jet aircraft on an aircraft carrier. He landed a De Havilland Sea Vampire on the Royal Navy carrier HMS Ocean.
- He holds the world's record for the most carrier landings, a total of 2,407

He has also written three books -

- *Wings of the Luftwaffe* - Capt Eric Brown (Airlife Publishing Ltd.) ISBN 1-85310-413-2
- *Wings of the Weird and Wonderful* - Capt Eric Brown
